This 23 minute video will be followed by a discussion and exploration of the idea of establishing **a living wage in Durango/LaPlata County**. The discussion will be led by Charlie Clements and individuals working on a Living Wage locally.



Charlie Clements is the Executive Director of the Carr Center for Human Rights Policy at the Harvard Kennedy School. Prior to coming to the Carr Center, Clements, a widely respected human rights activist and public health physician, served as CEO & president of Unitarian Universalist Service Committee from August 2003 until February 2010. While at UUSC, Charlie helped secure funding for the production of “La Marcha.”
